Dear Parents,

Thank you to Mrs Hopkins for spotting that our holiday request form on the website was a pdf version, making it impossible to complete electronically. There is now a Word version available and when submitting a request online, this should be via office@stpaul.wokingham.sch.uk.

You may be aware of the online game ROBLOX - Players can build their own "worlds", games and avatars. Although the recommended age is 12+, Kent Police have advised that during visits to a number of schools, many of the children (5-10 years old) using the ROBLOX app disclosed that they had secret online friends and had received inappropriate in game messages. The vast majority had failed to alert their parents that they had been approached online or that they had seen 'naked' characters doing very adult things within the game. If your child has a ROBLOX account, we would advise you to check and see if they have any virtual 'friends' that you are unaware of. You should also check the content of their inbox for inappropriate messages.

Please note there is still time to send in a 50p voluntary contribution towards last week's maths theatre workshop. The children enjoyed themselves tremendously and we were impressed by the quality of both productions. Your contributions make all the difference to us being able to continue to afford enrichment activities such as this.
