Reading

Read aloud to an adult for 20 minutes at least 4 times every week. During your reading, make sure you have answered at least 3 questions from different sections of the <u>Reading</u> <u>Booklet</u>. Then, discuss how you feel about what you have read. Ask the adult to write a comment in your Reading Journal.

Spelling

Remember the first week is learning and the second week is consolidation. Over the next week, we will be learning the 'other words' from the Statutory Spelling List in class (found below). Please test yourself on these words at home and check whether you have spelt each word correctly after you have written it. Stop testing yourself when you have spelt 10 words incorrectly. Learn how to spell 5 of these spellings in the first week and then learn how to spell the other 5 words during half term. What do these words mean? How can you use them in a sentence? Can you think of a way to remember how to spell them?

Share your class's word of the day with your family. Explain what it means and try to impress them by using it appropriately in conversation. Challenge them to find synonyms (words with a similar meaning).
