

As part of the National Flu Programme, 84% of our children were immunised. Please see the message below from Berkshire Healthcare NHS Foundation Trust,

"The Berkshire School Aged Immunisation team would like to thank you for your support with the delivery of the 19/20 childhood flu programme, without your help and support it would not be possible to deliver the programme safely or effectively. This academic year the team have administered over 57,000 doses of flu in over 340 schools, which will provide protection against the most common strains of flu this winter to those vaccinated, their families and the wider communities. We have achieved our target with an average uptake of over 65% for Berkshire, with the following breakdown of uptake per locality:

SLOUGH	43.6%
ROYAL BOROUGH OF WINDSOR, ASCOT AND MAIDENHEAD	69.1%
READING	64.5%
WOKINGHAM	77.3%
WEST BERKSHIRE	80.1%
