RSE is life long learning about physical, social, moral and emotional development. It is about the understanding of the importance of family life, stable loving relationships, respect, love and care. It is not about the promotion of sexual orientation or sexual activity. As part of this topic, the children will also be taught about the importance of respect for themselves and of others, and of the significance of relationships as key building blocks of community and society.

Any parents wishing to exercise their right to withdraw their child from PSRHE and Science lessons that explicitly teach Sex Education need to inform the school in writing by Friday, 11<sup>h</sup> June. The lessons that children can be withdrawn from are lessons 4 and 5 - indicated by an asterisk in the table above; the other lessons are all statutory. Parents who wish to exercise their right will be invited to speak to the Deputy or Headteacher who will explore any concerns and discuss any impact that withdrawal may have on their child.
