## Ancient Greek Day ~ Monday 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019

As part of our Ancient Greece topic, we have invited 'History Off The Page' into school to hold an Ancient Greek Day on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> April.

Through role-play, your child will experience life as it would have been in the year 490 BC. Using authentic tools and materials, they will learn skills as apprentices in a wide variety of workshops around the Agora (marketplace) in Athens. In the afternoon, the children will put on short theatrical performances at a banquet where they will be sampling Greek foods.

To make the experience all the more authentic, the children are invited to come to school dressed as Ancient Greeks and we ask that you help them in creating a very simple costume. Overleaf you will find some quick, easy, no sew ideas.

The PTA have very kindly subsidised the cost of this event and so the voluntary contribution we invite parents to make is reduced to  $\pounds$ 7.54 per child. This includes the cost of some Greek foods to taste, although the children will still need a school dinner or packed lunch on the day. Whilst you are under no obligation to contribute, if insufficient funds are received, we regret the activity will have to be cancelled. Payment can be made by cash, cheque or using our online payment system.





White adult t shirt and belt
