Please note:

- Children of key workers are not required to attend school, this is an optional service;
- School will be open from 8.30am-3.30pm;
- Entrance is via the Oxford Road entrance;
- Children should bring in a book to read, as they will be going straight into the hall at the start of every day where they will wait to be registered;
- There will be no formal teaching during the period of school closure but your child is welcome to bring in their home learning pack;
- Your child will need to bring a water bottle every day and a packed lunch on Monday 23rd. We are currently waiting for confirmation as to whether Caterlink will be deploying staff to St Paul's thereafter;
- Children are welcome to attend wearing their own clothes but please ensure they bring a coat and have sensible footwear as they will spend time outdoors every day;
- Once this system is underway if you require a place for your child, we respectfully ask that you contact us by 3.00pm the day before on keyworkers@stpauls.wokingham.sch.uk
- In the event of an absolute emergency, we will accommodate children on the day.
