ROYAL CYPHERS

Letter boxes prior to 1879 bore the VR cypher of Queen Victoria, but this was accidentally omitted from then until 1887. Every successive reign has brought a new cypher, the rarest being that of the short reign of Edward VIII in 1936. However, since 1953 boxes made for use in Scotland bear the Scottish crown instead of the usual E II R cypher, which is unacceptable to Scots.
