#### Reading

Read aloud to an adult for 20 minutes at least 4 times every week. During your reading, make sure you have answered at least 3 questions from different sections of the [Reading Booklet](#). Then, discuss how you feel about what you have read. Ask the adult to write a comment in your Reading Journal.

#### Spelling

Remember the first week is learning and the second week is consolidation. Over the next two weeks, we will be learning the 'other words' from the Statutory Spelling List (found below). Please test yourself on a selection of these words and learn any that you cannot yet spell. Discuss the meaning of these words. Can you find them in your reading book? If so, discuss why the author chose to use that word.
