You Tube has recently introduced a tool called 'Time Watched' which allows you to see how long your child has spent on the platform. There is an option to set a time limit and an option to block unsuitable sites.

Mobile Phones in School

This is on the understanding that they are switched off on arrival at the gates and handed to the class teacher for safekeeping. them with access to water, a school lunch and loan of PE kit. If for any reason a spare kit is not available, we will still ensure that we involve your child in the lesson. If you have forms or letters that need returning to the office, please post them in the Post Box situated on the wall of Meadow Nursery by our small wooden gate, when dropping off or picking up. This is emptied on a regular basis and saves you walking round to the main entrance and further unnecessary interruptions for the admin team.

If it is an absolute emergency and you have no choice but to drop off items, they should be left in the wooden box in the main reception. There you will find labels and a pen for you to mark the item with your child's name and class. House Captains will empty the box every day at 9.55-10.15am and also at lunchtime at 1.15pm.

If it becomes apparent as you drop your child off before school, that they have forgotten something, please reassure them that we will be able to provide an alternative in most cases. For musical instruments and any other specialist equipment that you will be bringing in, please remind them to come down and check the box themselves at break or lunch.

Maestros and iRock Music Lessons

If your child has a Maestros or iRock music lesson, please remind them in the morning what time their lesson is. Timetables are emailed directly to parents by iRock and Maestros, so please ensure that your child knows when their lesson time is. If they can't remember, all timetables are displayed on the notice board by the link doors in the playground so remind them to check.

School Photographs – date for the diary

The photographer will be in school on Monday 8th October 2018 to take individual and group photographs. If you have more than one child in school, we will arrange for them to be photographed together. If you have other children, either pre-school or older children, and would like them to be photographed with their siblings, the photographer will be in the hall from 8.00 am onwards and pictures will be taken on a first come, first-served basis. Please enter the school via the link doors from the playground. There could be a wait for this service, so we have advised Walter Infants/ Meadow Nursery that your child may arrive later than usual that morning.

Parents will receive the proof print in the first week after half term, and orders can placed online or by returning your order to school. Online orders for delivery to a home address will incur a postage and packaging fee (check proof print for costs). Orders placed through school will not incur a postage and packaging fee. Orders should be received within 2 weeks of the cut-off date for placing orders.

PE & Games

Reminder: For outdoor games, the children are permitted to wear a plain navy or black tracksuit. Football Team shirts, whilst very popular, are not school kit and therefore not allowed. They are permitted for clubs only. Even if a child has lunchtime football and an after school club, they will not be allopwed to stay in football team strip between lunch and the end of the school day, as this is not school uniform and unfair to every other child who follows the school rules.


