On Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> March, St Paul's will be celebrating World Book Day with a range of activities based around books and authors. The children are welcome to come into school dressed as their favourite storybook character – they will need to be ready to discuss what it is about that character that appeals to them.

As part of a national initiative, each child will receive a £1 World Book Day token which can be used either to exchange, at a book shop, for a specially published short book or to receive £1 off books costing £2.99 or more.

The children have the perfect opportunity to use their tokens at the Travelling Book Fair which will be visiting St Paul's from Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> March until Monday 16<sup>th</sup> March. As long as the weather is fine, the fair will open from 3:45 - 4:15 on Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday and the following Monday outside the Year 4 classrooms; if it is wet, the times will be the same but the fair will be in 4A and 4L.
