Monday's assembly for Year 3 and Year 4 children was based on 'Chicken Clicking', a cautionary rhyming tale by Tony Ross and Jeanne Willis. The story is about Chick getting carried away using online shopping and friendship sites, only to discover that not everything is as it seems.

Assembly for Year 5 and 6 pupils focused on how there are few real-world places where children occupy the same space as teens, young adults and older adults without constant supervision. We discussed how social media sites are designed to attract as wide a demographic as possible and are not necessarily 'child friendly', hence why each has an age restriction. Whilst it is parental choice as to the freedoms that a child has online, if you allow your child to use social media to chat to friends and family or share images, Internet Matters, has a list of social media quides to help

get you up to speed on the most popular platforms and how to help your child set the right privacy settings to remain safe.

If your child gets means-tested free school meals you are entitled to financial support. Wokingham Borough Council and First Days Children's Charity are working together to provide payments to help during school holidays. <u>Apply through First Days</u> <u>Children's Charity</u>.

You can get £15 per week, per eligible child, during school holidays. This applies for half terms, Christmas and Easter holidays. It will be back paid to October half-term if you've not already applied.




