


IMPORTANT MESSAGE

Twice in the last few weeks, a family member has arrived to collect a child who has already been picked up. In both cases, the parent collecting had forgotten to advise the person picking up that the plans had changed. In the event of being notified a child has gone missing, we send staff to search the streets around school, whilst others walk the route home. At the same time, we begin working down the list of emergency contacts, ringing all of the numbers we have been provided with.

In both cases, it took some considerable time to establish that the child was safe, which was highly distressing for all concerned. In future, if we are unable to locate a missing pupil within 10 minutes of being notified, we will alert the local police to ensure that if it is in fact a case of abduction, the emergency services are able to respond swiftly.

It is vital that you remember to advise family members and friends should you make any changes to requests to pick up on your behalf, and crucial you keep school informed of any changes to emergency contact details, including mobile phone numbers.

Pupil Safety



It is impossible to see children safely off the premises at the end of the day because of congestion in and around the gates. Parents are not permitted to wait in the mouth of either the wooden or the metal gates to enable staff on duty have an unrestricted view of pupils exiting the site.

When collecting children, please stand in the designated Year Group areas. If you have more than one child attending our school, please stand in the area for your youngest – older siblings will join you there.
