Black History Month

Black History Month has been marked in the UK for more than 30 years. It celebrates the history, arts and culture of black British people. Awareness of, and education about, the history of white British people is well-established, but black British history is underreported and underrepresented. Dedicating a month to it every year helps redress that balance, and helps us all learn more about our shared History as Britons. This year's theme is Time for Change: Action Not Words.



In assembly this week, we have been learning about why we mark Black History month and about Joe Clough, the first ever black bus driver in Britain.
