Swimming Timetable

Swimming is part of the statutory PE curriculum and lessons will commence on Monday 22nd May, replacing indoor PE sessions.

On swimming days, pupils should come to school in uniform, bringing the following kit with them:

- Girls one-piece swimsuit
- Boys swimming trunks no long, baggy shorts please!
- Towel
- Swimming hat (these can be purchased online through the school website)
- Optional extra: Goggles with the BSi mark.

For children to participate safely in PE and Swimming lessons, all earrings must be removed and we advise earrings remain at home on these days for safekeeping.

Children will also need to be able to fit their own swimming hat, so please practise with them over the weekend.

Lessons focus on the skills needed to swim confidently across all four strokes, as well as self-rescue. As with any activity, your child's safety and enjoyment is our number one priority. Please remind them about the importance of poolside safety and that every child will be expected to follow the instructions of the adults first time, every time, stopping immediately they hear the whistle.

- One short burst on the whistle stop
- Continuous bursts on the whistle exit the pool

Swimming is part of the national curriculum and therefore compulsory, all children are expected to participate unless we are advised in writing by a medical practitioner.

Attendance

Good school attendance is vital to your child's education and wellbeing. Children who attend school regularly are more likely to feel settled in school, maintain friendships, keep up with their learning and gain the greatest benefit from their education. There are only 190 school days each year, leaving 175 days for holidays, appointments and other events that would otherwise impact on learning. The target for all pupils is a minimum of 95% attendance.

Reporting absences

If your child is absent from School, please email <u>absence@stpauls.wokingham.sch.uk</u> or ring school on 0118 978 5219 to let us know that your child is not well enough to attend school but **we will <u>require it in writing also</u>**. We request that we receive this <u>no later than 8.30am</u>. It is important that we have the correct information for our registers.

When sending emails to the school, please include the child's full name and class. If your child is off due to vomiting and diarrhoea, they must not return to school within 48 hours of the final episode.

Cost of Living Help Hub

Wokingham have pulled information, help and support together in one place, to help families who are struggling to pay for food, energy bills and other essential household items. Nut Policy

We do not permit any items in school containing nuts. Please check packaging carefully when choosing items for lunch boxes and break time snacks. Playtime snacks can be any of the following - fruit, vegetable sticks, dried fruit and nut free cereal bars. Crisps, chocolate, biscuits and sweets are not permitted at break.



Families eligible for Free School Meals

If your child gets means-tested free school meals you are entitled to financial support. Wokingham Borough Council and First Days Children's Charity are working together to provide payments to help during school holidays. <u>Apply through First Days Children's Charity.</u>

You can get £15 per week, per eligible child, during school holidays. This applies for half terms, Christmas and Easter holidays. It will be back paid to October half-term if you've not already applied.


